

2010 Illinois League Golf Tournament

**Shamble Format – The Donald Ross Course at French Lick
Saturday, September 11, 2010 – 1:00 pm**

The **Illinois Golf Tournament** has been scheduled for **Saturday afternoon, September 11th**, on the **Donald Ross Course at French Lick**. The Donald Ross Course was originally constructed in 1917 and has been the home to many regional and national tournaments, including the 2010 PGA National Championship. The course recently underwent an incredible transformation in collaboration with the Donald Ross Society that saw the return of 35 original bunkers featuring Ross’ trademark flat bottoms and deep, gnarly faces; greens expanded to their original square or rectangular shapes; and medal tees that play to 7,000 yards.

Play will begin at **1:00 pm SHARP!!!** Make sure your clubs are at the Pro Shop the evening before the Tournament. The bags will be placed on the carts prior to your arrival.

CLUB RENTAL AND STORAGE

If you bring your clubs, they can be stored at the Pro Shop at your expense and charged to your room. We suggest that you contact the Resort’s Pro Shop for rental clubs in advance **1-812-936-5855**. Rental Clubs are also paid by the individuals. The cost of club rental is **not** included in the Tournament Fee. Club Rental should be charged to your room.

The **Tournament Fee \$165** includes greens fees, cart, golf pro services, tournament prizes, lunch and beverage costs.
